(Ce)² Workshop Warsaw, 1-2 July 2019

Organised by CenEA in cooperation with CeMMAP

Keynote address in the Lecture Series in Honour of Leonid Hurwicz:

The (Ce)² workshop is a joint initiative of the Centre for Economic Analysis (CenEA, Poland) and the Centre for Microdata Methods and Practice (CeMMAP, UK). The sixth edition of the workshop will take place in Warsaw on 1-2 July 2019.

The workshop aims at covering topics in microeconomic theory and applications, and will particularly welcome studies in the following fields:

Microeconomic applications

- Economics of education, skills, and training
- Trade, technology and labor markets
- Identification challenges in applied microeconomics
- Empirical analyses in economic history

Microeconomic theory

- Games: theory and experiments
- Information economics
- Communication and networks
- Voting and mechanism design

Organization:

Only full papers are considered (early versions are welcome). Authors will have 50 minutes for their presentation and they will be expected to discuss another paper presented at the workshop. The total number of presentations will not exceed 16.

Procedures:

There is no conference fee but participants are expected to cover their own travel and accommodation costs. Online submission via ce2@cenea.org.pl opens on 2 January 2019. The submission deadline is 5 April 2019. Notifications are expected by 19 April 2019.

Once the main programme is finalised, a separate call will be announced for poster presentations.

WIEM 2019

Participants of the (Ce)² Workshop are also encouraged to take part in the XIVth Warsaw International Economic Meeting (WIEM) on 2-4 July 2019, as presenters or audience members. The Hurwicz keynote address, held on the afternoon of July 2nd, is also the opening event for WIEM. The Warsaw International Economic Meeting attracts around 100 speakers and covers all topics of economic analysis. It has been organised by the Faculty of Economic Sciences of the University of Warsaw in partnership with CenEA.
