The Ce² Workshop takes place on 1st and 2nd of July 2019 in Lubomirski Palace, Business Centre Club (BCC) in the centre of Warsaw (see point A on the map below). After the first day of the workshop at 6:30 p.m. all presenters are welcome to join the workshop dinner (Restaurant *KROMKI* - Jana Pawła II 45a/38, 01-008 Warsaw; point K on the map). The workshop concludes on Tuesday afternoon (July, 2nd) with the 2019 edition of the Keynote Lecture Series in Honour of Leonid Hurwicz. This year's keynote address will be given by prof. Jörn-Steffen Pischke.


Useful information

On the official webpage of Warsaw you can find some general information about the city, together with suggestions for accommodation and tourist attractions. The most convenient way to travel around Warsaw is by public transport. Detailed information regarding bus, tram and underground options can be found on Google Maps.

We have prepared a short information on how to get to the Worskhop (BCC; point A on the map):

- 1. From main train/bus station WARSZAWA CENTRALNA (point D) take a 20 mins walk or:
- •Take a tram 10, 17, 33 or 41 and take off at "Hala Mirowska" stop (point C). From here you have a 5 min walk to the BCC (point A).
- Single one-way transfer ticket for 20 min for bus/tram in ZONE 1 costs 3,40 PLN. You can buy it at ticket machines with cash or (in most cases) a credit card. Make sure to validate the ticket once inside the bus/tram.
- 2. From the CHOPIN AIRPORT (point F):
- Take a train S2 to train station "Warszawa Śródmieście" (point E), then walk shortly to "Centrum" tram stop (point H) and take a tram 4, 15, 18, 35. Get off at "Królewska" stop (point B). From here you have a 5 min walk to the BCC (point A).
- •Take a bus 175 or a train S3 to main train/bus station "Warszawa Centralna" (point D). For further instructions see point 1.
- Single one-way transfer ticket for 75 min for bus, tram and train from the airport (ZONE 1) costs 4,40 PLN. You can buy it at ticket machines with cash or (in most cases) a credit card. Make sure to validate the ticket inside the bus/tram/train.
- 3. From the MODLIN AIRPORT (point G):
- •Take ModlinBUS (direction "Warszawa Centrum (Pałac Kultury)", point I). From here you have a 15 min walk to the BCC (point A).

Single one-way ticket for ModlinBus costs ca 30-40 PLN. You can buy it with your credit card at the airport shop or online
