After the first day of the workshop at 7:30 p.m. all presenters are welcome to join the workshop dinner (Restaurant *Opasły Tom* - point K on the map). The workshop concludes on Thursday afternoon (July, 2nd) with the 2015 edition of Keynote Lecture Series in Honour of Leonid Hurwicz. Prof. John van Reenen will deliver this year's keynote address.

WIEM Conference 2015

The lecture is also an opening event for the Warsaw International Economic Meeting (WIEM) 2015, held between 2nd-4th of July. Ce² Workshop participants are kindly invited to join academic part of the WIEM conference after registering (conference program and other details are available on the conference website). Registration, the first session of the conference and the reception take place in Lubomirski Palace as well. The rest of the conference is held nearby at the Faculty of Economic Sciences at University of Warsaw (10 min walk, point J on the map).

Useful information

The most convenient way to travel around Warsaw is by public transport. Detailed information regarding bus, tram and underground options can be found on the following website.

We have prepared a short information on how to get to the Worskhop (BCC; point A on the map):

1. From main train/bus station WARSZAWA CENTRALNA (point D):

•Take a bus nr 160 or 109 (departing every 4 min) which goes to bus stop "Plac Grzybowski" (point C). From here you have a 5 min walk through a park to the BCC (point A).

Single one-way transfer ticket for 20 min for bus and tram in ZONE 1 costs 3,40 PLN (1,70 PLN for students). You can buy it at ticket machines with a credit card. Make sure to validate the ticket once inside the bus/tram.

2. From the CHOPIN AIRPORT (point F):

•Take a train S2 (departs every 30 min) to train station "Warszawa Śródmieście" (point E), then walk shortly to "Centrum" tram stop (point H) and take a tram 17 (direction "Metro Młociny") or 35 (direction "Nowe Bemowo") or 15 (direction "Marymont – Potok") or 4 (direction "Żerań Wschodni"). Get off at "Królewska" tram stop (point B). From here you have a 5 min walk to the BCC (point A).

- •Take a bus 175 (direction "Plac Piłsudskiego") and get off at "Centrum" bus stop (point H). For further instructions see the point above.
- •Take a less frequent train S3 (departs every 69 min) to main train/bus station "Warszawa Centralna" (point D). For further instructions see point 1.

Single one-way transfer ticket for 75 min for bus, tram and train from the airport (ZONE 1) costs 4,40 PLN (2,20 PLN for students). You can buy it at ticket machines with a credit card. Make sure to validate the ticket inside the bus/tram.

3. From the MODLIN AIRPORT (point G):

•Take ModlinBUS (direction "Plac Defilad", point I). From here you have a 15 min walk to the BCC (point A). Single one-way ticket for ModlinBus costs ca 20-30 PLN. You can buy it with your credit card at the airport shop or online on modlinbus.com.
