All economists are invited to submit their unpublished analytical work or new research in all areas of economics with special focus on macroeconomics, international trade, labour economics, education, microeconomics, industrial organization, finance and econometrics. Young economists, such as graduate students or post-docs are encouraged to apply. Participants are expected to serve as discussants of other papers presented in the same session.

Procedures: Conference language is English. Both individual authors and chairs of organized sessions should submit extended abstracts or full papers using submission form at <http://www.wiem-conference.pl>. Submissions must describe: (1) objectives, (2) methodology and (3) results of the research. Submissions of organized sessions will receive priority in the allotment of time slots.

Finances: Conference fee is 100 euro (paid upon notification of acceptance). Conference participants are expected to cover all other associated costs, such as travel and accommodation.

Prize: As in previous years, the Best Paper Prize for Young Economists will be awarded to up to three outstanding presentations; the budget is at least 1500 euro.
