Getting from the hotel to the National Museum on Sunday

You can take <u>a 35mins walk to the Museum</u> right through the centre of Warsaw.

<u>There are several options for the public transport – all available in Google Maps.</u>

You can combine taking Tram 24 from the stop "Muzeum Powstania Warszawskiego" to the stop "Muzeum Narodowe" with a 13mins walk.

You can take a short ride with Metro line 2 from the stop "Rondo ONZ" to "Nowy Swiat-Uniwersytet" and completed with a 20mins walk.

You can ride 3 stops with Bus 157 from the stop "Mennica" to "Plac Starynkiewicza" and change to Tram 9 for another 4 stops until the stop "Muzeum Narodowe".

You can combine Bus 106 from the stop "Mennica" to the stop "Zacheta" (4 stops) with Bus 111 for another 4 stops until the stop "Muzeum Narodowe".

To use any public transport you must purchase and validate a zone 1 time ticket from a ticket machine (most with card payments) at bus stops or inside a bus/tram/city train/subway, or through the app mobiLET (in ENG).

Individual transport

<u>Uber</u> and <u>Bolt</u> are available in Warsaw. But if you prefer a taxi, use <u>ELE Taxiapp</u> (in ENG) or call +48 22 811 11 11 (in ENG), while calling specify that you pay with card and/or need an invoice. We caution against hailing any unmarked taxis, or boarding one without having agreed on the rate for the ride.
